APPENDIX 3: THRESHOLD FOR 5PU PREDICTIONS

The question now arises as to the threshold: at what point do we deem a prediction to be a failure? In our previous work on UK elections we identified those elections deemed to be polling failures by common consent and worked backwards from there. In the UK those elections were 1951, 1970, 1992, 2015 and 2017 so can we use them here? Unfortunately we could not get opinion polling records at a five-party level for most past elections. So in the end we settled on 2015 (deemed a failure) and 2019 (deemed a success): a point in between would yield a threshold. The results are below

2019 MAE(5PU)

2019 GE is regarded as a UK polling success. Its MAE on a five-party-unforced basis is 1%, as shown below.

Introduction

On Mar 10th 2022 the Democracy and Elections Centre at Royal Holloway held an EventBrite lecture on the French Presidential Election. The host was Chris Hanretty (Royal Holloway), and the speakers were:

- Giacomo Benedetto (Royal Holloway), speaking on the non-radical left;
- Elodie Fabre (Queen's University Belfast), speaking on Emmanuel Macron and La République en Marche
- Aurelien Mondon (Bath), speaking on the far right

The author attended the conference and took the notes below

Giacomo Benedetto (GB)

GB was the first speaker. He pointed out that the French non-radical left are spent: most have moved to Macron, others elsewhere. GB believed that the Socialists would do very badly. He considered that the centre-left at this point is finished at presidential and national level, tho' not at local level. The Greens had done well in some local cities and towns, securing them from the Socialists and the Right. He pointed out that Macron's party may do well at presidential level but does not do well at regional level

Elodie Fabre (EF)

EF then spoke. She pointed out that Macron's victory in 2017 had a precedent in 1974, where Valéry Giscard d'Estaing beat the establishment candidate, but also noted that VGDE had not gone on to win in 1981. Macron presented himself as a grassroots candidate in 2017 and was the beneficiary of left-wing voters who defected from the Socialists' left-wing turn post-Hollande. Since then En Marche has gotten seats in Parliament and Macron the Presidency, but volunteers have become disillusioned as it contains no connection between local and leadership and – as there's no membership subscription – it's difficult to assess the number of members. But having said that Macron is facing a shattered opposition and is favourite to win 2022.

Aurelien Mondon (AM)

AM opened by saying that although Jean-Marie LePen was the classic far-right candidate, his daughter and successor marine LePen had been more emollient, with some success, having nearly won in 2017. In fact her mainstreaming approach may have resulted in other parties outflanking her on the right. In 2022 the Culture

Wars, cancel culture, critical race theory, etc are part of the national debate and Zemmour is filling the gap that LePen has left. Zemmour is a writer (welcome to French politics), an admirer of Petain and is popular with the media, gaining support from the Right. LePen is in a pincer, caught by Zemmour on her right and Macron on her left. Nevertheless it is not impossible she may win

Q&A: Question from Matthew Shaddick

Matthew Shaddick is the Head of Political Markets at Smarkets. He asked the panel to discuss Péresse. GB said that she was a compromise candidate between Éric Ciotti on the right and Xavier Bertrand on the left, and enthused few. EF said that Péresse had no new ideas, seen as compromising her personal morals and is a poor public speaker

Q&A: Question from person A

Person A asked a question “what would it take to maximise LePen’s chances in 2022”. AM said that she is strangled by her own success, having tacked so far to the centre she is losing votes to her right. GB said that Zemmour is crashing.

Q&A: Question from person B

Person B asked “what is the impact of the French Presidency of the Council of the European Union”? GB said that the association with statesmen normally helps an incumbent, but Ukraine and Putin nullified that. EF preferred that elections really should not be held during this period, although GB pointed out that electoral calendar made that difficult.

Q&A: Question from Chris Prosser.

Dr Christopher Prosser is a politics lecturer at the Royal Holloway. He asked about the implications of the Ukraine conflict. AM said that Russian money makes the Right nicer to Putin than they would otherwise be, plus they both agree on “woke”. However, Zemmour’s vote is collapsing due to his association with Putin, whereas Macron is receiving a boost. EF noted that there is a paradoxical “rally round the flag” effect, with Macron being seen as a statesman in his association with Putin and thus receiving a boost even though Macron courted Putin as an ally against China.

Q&A: Question from person C

Person C asked “if Mélenchon gets thru to round two, then what?”? All agreed that Mélenchon would lose, with the panel noting that the left’s historical and Mélenchon’s personal antipathy to NATO would be a problem given the Ukraine war. Unlike the UK, where NATO membership is a settled matter, it is still a live issue in France. AM pointed out that turnout might be important.

Q&A: Question from Chris Hanretty

Professor Christopher Hanretty is a Professor of Politics at Royal Holloway and the host of this presentation. He asked “what about media influence”. EF said that she had left France 20 years ago, so could not opine from experience, but noted that legislation had been introduced to ensure equal time (hence Zemmour’s fall in support) and that although Macron had refused to take part in the first debate he will for the second. AM said that new legislation forced Zemmour to abandon his job and resultant media exposure and that although he has connections to right-wing media owners he had little grassroots support.

Q&A: Question from Timothy Martyn Hill

Timothy Martyn Hill is a statistician who works in the private sector and is the author of this article. Noted that the panel seems to think that it will be Macron/LePen in the second round, and asked about the implications. EF said that *if* it is Macron/LePen then lower turnout may help LePen make Macron’s margin lower. AM agreed but noted that Mélenchon was close to LePen last time and history may repeat. GB noted that Mélenchon is abstentionist (does not vote in round two if there isn’t a left-wing candidate) and that that may affect round two

Q&A: Question from Chris Hanretty

“What about Covid?”. AM and EF agreed that it was not a problem and that Macron’s volte-face adoption of a pro-state stance helped.

Q&A: Question from Chris Hanretty and Matthew Shaddock

“The odds on a Macron victory is currently about 90%. Comment?”. AM agreed. GB said that neither LePen nor Mélenchon can beat him, and that for Pécresse to win she would have to change her personality and her policies which isn’t going to happen. EF agreed that Pécresse was the only one who could win but had blown it.

Q&A: Question from Chris Hanretty

“Are the legislative elections scheduled for later in 2022 now second-order?” [A second-order election is one used by the electorate to register an opinion on another election/event instead of the intended actual election]. EF said probably, but also noted that En Marche has problems at Parliamentary level due to lack of volunteers. GB said that the change to the electoral calendar reduced the chance of split-ticketing, and Hanretty speculated that *cohabitation* may be a thing of the past.

The connections here are not obvious, but there is a degree of continuity here as the parties have changed their name, merged, supported or otherwise changed over time. Attempting to trace them thru gives us these very approximate and incomplete categories:

- **Gaullists:** UNR->UDR->RPR->UMP->LR
- **Communists:** PCF->FG
- **Trotskyists:** VO->LO
- **Socialists:** CIR->FGDS->SFIO/CIR->PS
- **Republicans:** FNRI->PR->UDF->MoDem->LR
- **Christian Democrats:** MRP->CD->CDS->FD->UDF
- **National Front:** FN->RN
- **Eurosceptics:** MDC->PR->MRC
- **Green:** LV->EELV
- **Unsure/own category/other:** DVG, CTV, EM, LFI

But we are falling into a trap here: we are attempting to place an overarching long-term structure on a country that just hasn't got one: France has parties with shorter lifespans than we are used to. Even worse, we are doing it from the author's best guesses which while defensible are still a subjective interpretation and might be wrong - where would one put UDF? En Marche? Are you sure? So we need a better solution.
